Said Friends' Chair, John Davis: "The Berryhill Fields have come a long way since they were saved from the threat Open Cast mining in the mid-90s and reclaimed for future generations as a Millennium Project."

This included providing improved access around the Fields, creating a number of Millennium features such as the Friends' Stone Circle and the three Berryhill Greenway gateway features, and exploring the history of the site with a number of archaeological digs.
